Qualifications

- 4. Enjoys teaching students about gardening
- 5. Has prior experience working with students

Responsibilities

- Maintain The Dock's greenhouse and gardens (including but not limited to managing supplies, watering plants, choosing plants to grow, setting the temperature, etc.)
- 2. Teach students weekly (starting with upper elementary and then working up to middle school and high school as well as down to lower elementary over time)
- 3. Coordinate and present lesson plans in age-appropriate and engaging ways
- 4. Work with volunteers during lessons
- 5. Coordinate with and report to The Dock's Director
