Agil Abdullayev

b. 1992, Baku, Azerbaijan

"I use art to explore and challenge societal structures, unraveling the complexities of identity, memory, and the intersections of queerness and culture".

Agil Abdullayev is a non-binary contemporary artist whose multidisciplinary practice spans video, photography, and painting. Abdullayev's work delves into the intricacies of queerness, trauma, escapism and identity, weaving personal memory with the cultural and historical narratives of Azerbaijani and South Caucasian traditions. Their art creates a space where gender identity and personal experiences are reimagined, confronting societal constructs and opening pathways for broader dialogues.

Abdullayev's journey as an artist is rooted in a robust educational background. Currently studying at Städelschule - Hochschule für Bildende Künst (class of Judith Hopf) in Frankfurt, Germany, the artist completed a residency at the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture, Maine, USA, in 2023. Abdullayev earned their BA in Fine Art with first-class honors from Nottingham Trent University, UK, in 2018, following a foundation studies in Art and Design at Nottingham Trent International College, UK, in 2015. These formative experiences deeply inform their interdisciplinary, research-based practice.

Often inspired by artists such as David Hockney and Ellsworth Kelly, Abdullayev plays with the fluidity between private and public spaces. Challenging conventional boundaries between these domains, the artist's work merges intimate moments with universal themes, using vibrant colors and experimental compositions that resonate on a broader scale. Through the transformation of private, internal experiences into shared visual languages, the artist creates spaces where individual histories of trauma, joy, and identity are made visible and present.

Central to Abdullayev's practice is the concept of the queer body as an archive, where personal and transhistorical memories collide. This framework dissolves fixed gender categories and allows for new expressions of identity, liberation, and belonging.

Abdullayev's work pushes traditional artistic boundaries, transforming deeply personal narratives into collective experiences that challenge cultural perceptions and redefine the intersection of queerness and art.

Through a multidisciplinary practice, the artist invites viewers to engage with the nuances of identity, queerness, and societal change while challenging, rearticulating, and reinventing stereotyped narratives.
