### Shahnaz Aghayeva

b. 1984, Azerbaijan

"I want my art to question and disrupt the limited perception of women's lives and identities, revealing the hidden dimensions of femininity that are rarely seen or understood".

Shahnaz Aghayeva is an artist who divides her time between Baku and Bodrum, and her work pulses with an intense, visceral energy that defies easy categorization. Self-taught and fearless in her approach, Shahnaz explores complex themes surrounding female identity through a range of mediums - metal, linoleum, wood, glass, and cardboard - always challenging herself to find new forms and processes. Her art is grounded in a raw, subterranean power, a reflection of her commitment to revealing the oftenunspoken realities of women's experiences.

Shahnaz's work is deeply personal and politically charged, questioning the depiction of women in societies where perception is often dominated by the male gaze. For Shahnaz, being a woman artist means confronting the constraints placed on women's identities, especially in Eastern cultures. She believes that the reality of women's lives - their shared influences, inherited wounds, and complex relationships - is largely unseen and misunderstood by men. Through her art, she aims to give voice to these hidden narratives, addressing the aspects of female identity that only women recognize and challenging societal expectations.

Her pieces often depict women exclusively, utilizing recurring symbols such as long hair, representing the intimate care women use to organize and protect their lives. Shahnaz's work also draws inspiration from figures like Louise Bourgeois, with stylized forms that balance sensuality and defiance. Between abstraction and figuration, her images of nude female figures manipulate scale and perspective, reflecting a dynamic interplay between women's changing roles, identity, and sexual freedom as society's view of gender evolves.

In challenging conventional perspectives, Shahnaz's work seeks to redefine femininity, inviting viewers to engage with the deeper complexities of gender and female empowerment.

Through her art, she hopes to influence how future generations perceive women, pushing beyond traditional aesthetics to create a space where women's voices and experiences shape the narrative.

Shahnaz Aghayeva's works have been showcased in several prominent museum exhibitions. In 2018, her art was featured at the National Taiwan Museum of Fine Arts. The following year, in 2019, her work was part of the "From Waste to Art" exhibition at the Gala Museum Complex in Azerbaijan. In 2022, Shahnaz exhibited at both the Istanbul Museum of Graphic Arts (IMOGA) and the İBB Museum of Graphic Arts, further solidifying her presence in the international art scene.
