At anytime for any reason, we may need to cancel or alter an activity, program or holiday. We will inform you of any necessary changes with as much notice as possible.

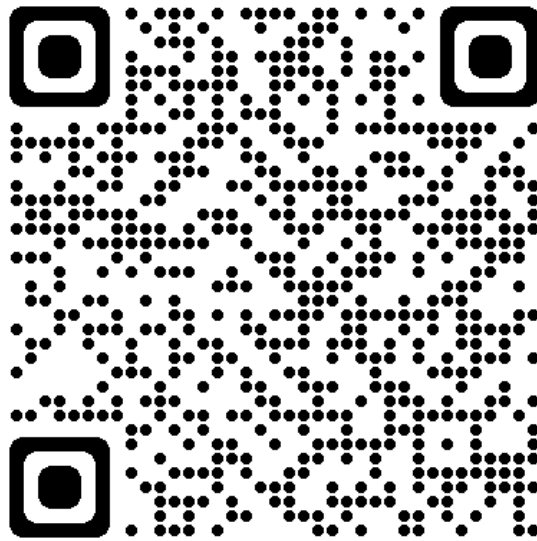

Brooklyn NSW is a quaint village located at the entrance of the Hawkesbury River and along the Sydney - Newcastle train line.

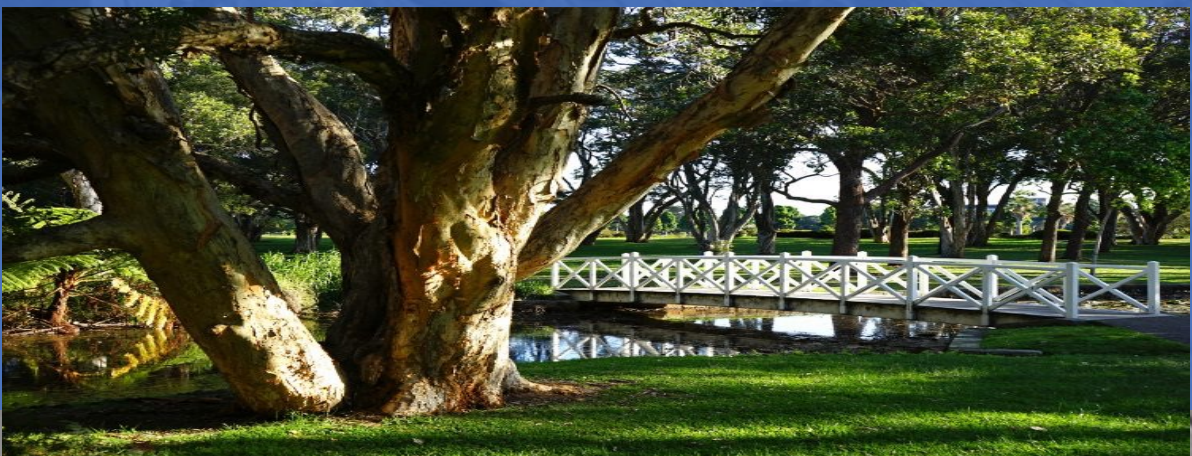
The village is surrounded by bays, boats and green hills. So wherever you stand, the view is always picturesque.
