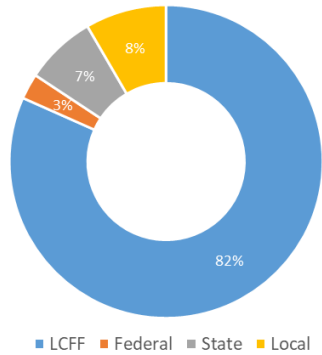

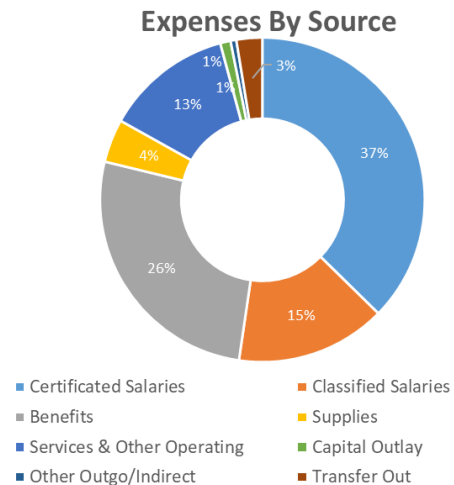

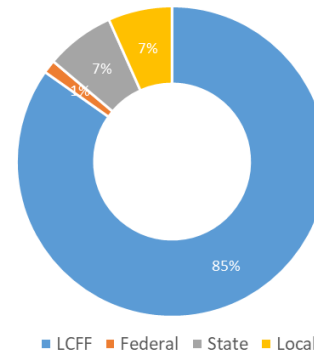
General Fund Current Budget (FY 23/24)  
Revenues By Source



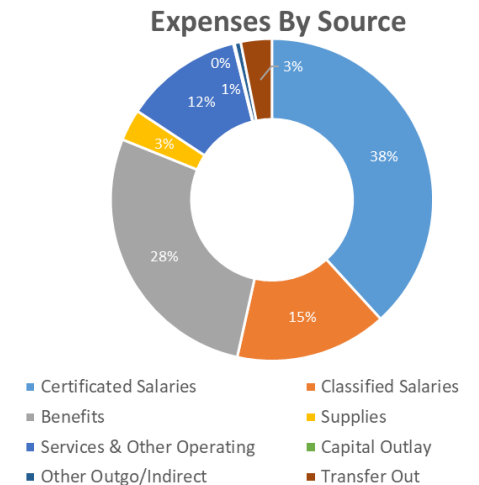
General Fund Current Budget (FY 23/24)

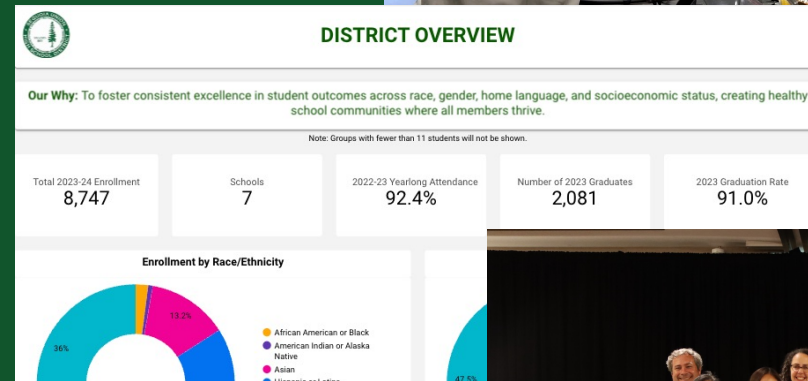
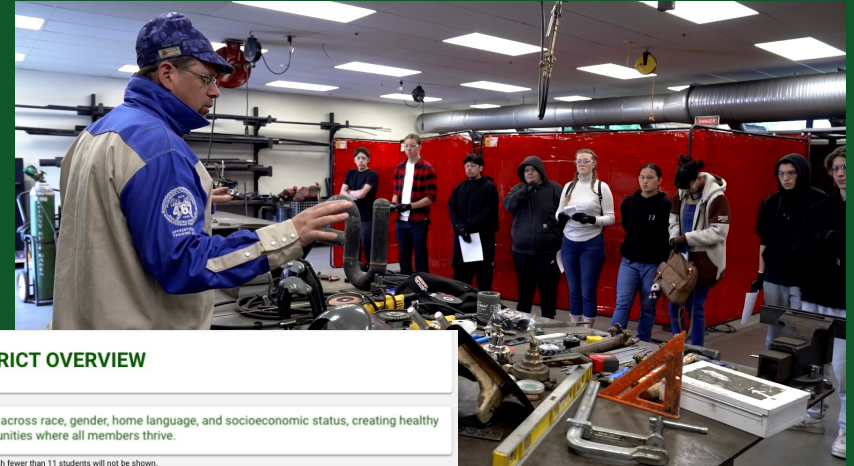
Revenues and Expenses by Source

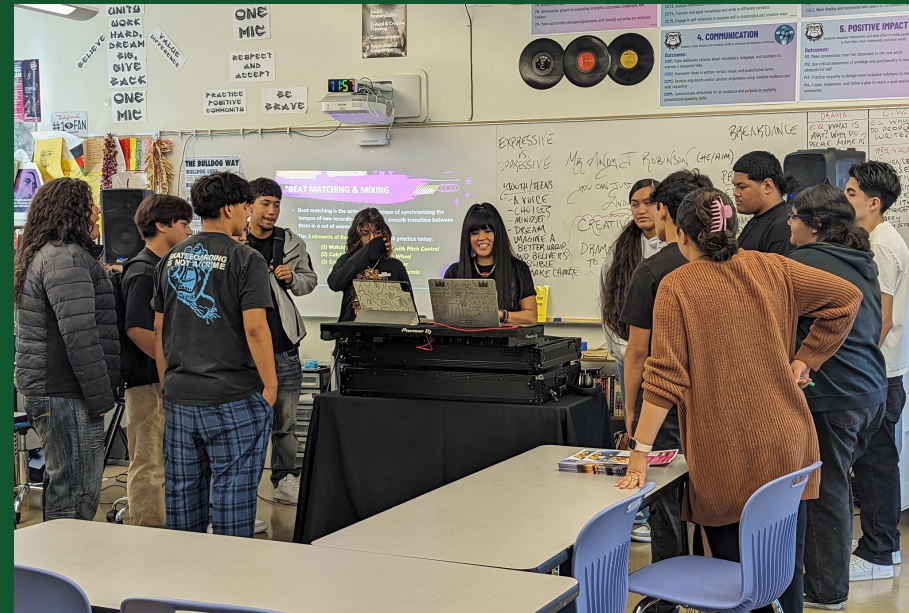

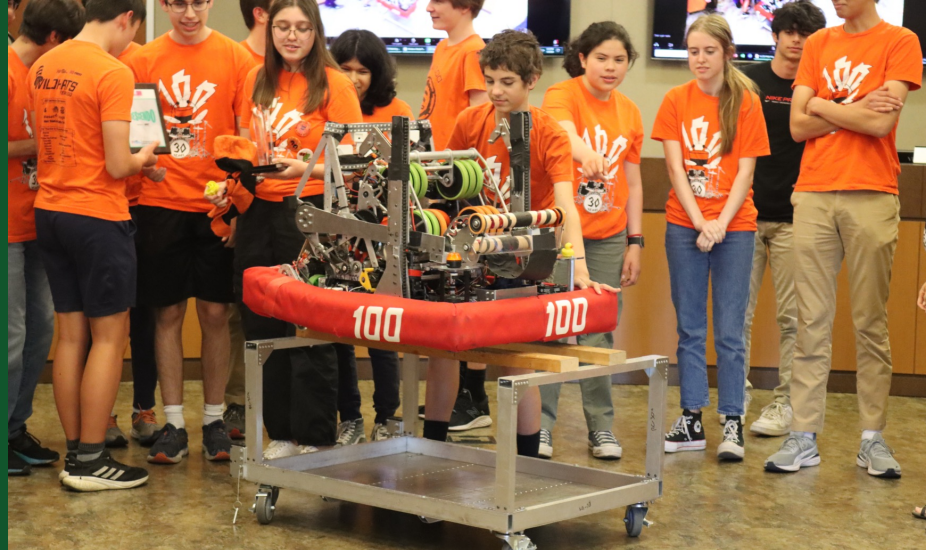
