

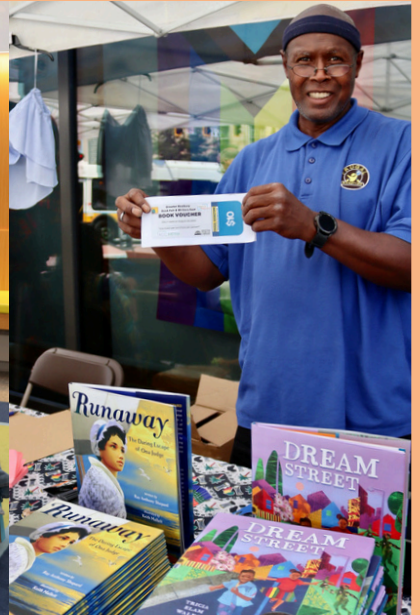

SPONSORSHIP TIERS

READING CHANGES LIVES PATRON - \$5,000

Sponsors at this level fuel the fair's highest-impact programming, including keynote speakers, featured authors, and major community workshops. Their support ensures broad public access and brings nationally recognized literary voices to the event.

GROWING MINDS GUILD - \$2,500

This tier sustains core educational experiences for kids and teenagers—youth writing labs, panel discussions, and interactive storytelling sessions. Funding helps us cover teaching artists, materials, and space for community-centered learning.

SEEDS OF COMMUNITY SOCIETY - \$1,000

Contributions support essential program elements such as author talks and moderated conversations. Sponsors help cultivate the intimate, idea-sharing spaces that make the fair vibrant and meaningful.

AUTHOR MEET UP CIRCLE - \$500

This level directly uplifts our participatory creative programs. Funds help provide supplies, facilitation costs, and community-building activities that welcome emerging writers and local voices and pave the way for future writing opportunities and successes.

STORYTELLING SUPPORTER - \$100

Entry-level sponsors help maintain free access to the fair, supporting logistics like signage, volunteer hospitality, and basic program needs. Every contribution helps keep the book fair open and accessible to all.
